| <b>awe</b>              | A feeling of great respect for someone or something.  |
| <b>church</b>           | A building where some Christians go to pray.  |
| <b>community</b>        | A group of people who live in the same area or share common interests, beliefs or activities. |
| <b>congregation</b>     | A group of people gathered for a service in a place of worship.                               |
| <b>equality</b>         | Everyone being equal in terms of rights, treatment and opportunities.                         |
| <b>gurdwara</b>         | A Sikh place of worship, also spelt gurudwara.  |
| <b>place of worship</b> | A building or space where some people go to worship.  |
| <b>sacred</b>           | Something that is greatly respected and treated with care, especially in religious contexts.  |
| <b>synagogue</b>        | A special place where Jewish people gather for worship, prayer and community.                 |
| <b>worship</b>          | Showing love, respect and praise to a god or gods.  |
