This term we are learning to show interest in stories and answer simple questions, use sounds and letters to read simple words and check they make sense, recognise some tricky words and recall book titles, begin writing names and simple captions, and say a short sentence and count the words before writing.

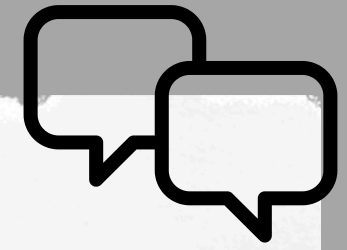
Physical Development
