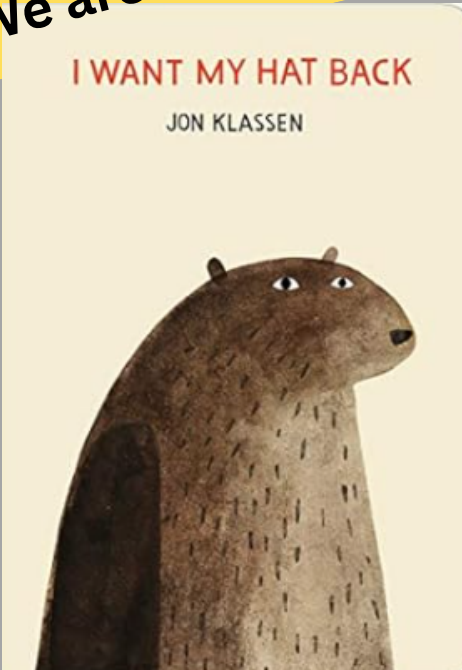


English

We are learning to add and subtract numbers within 10 using a part-whole model and a number line. We are learning to name 2D and 3D shapes and describe their properties.

Our focus in PSHCE this term is health and wellbeing. We will be learning about how we can look after our bodies and minds in a range of ways and who are the people who help us to stay safe and healthy.

Geography

We will learn about aerial photographs and maps. We will explore symbols used on maps and begin to use simple directional vocabulary such as near, far, forwards, backwards.



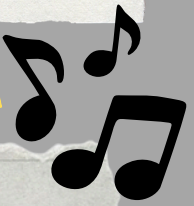
Computing

We will be learning what data is. We will explore how to collect data and sort data. We will look at pictograms to read and interpret data and use digital tools to create and explore data digitally.



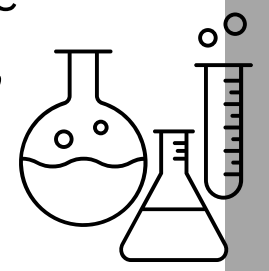
Music
