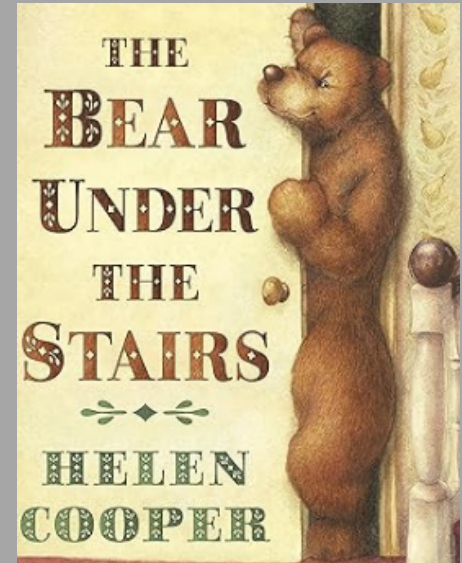


# English

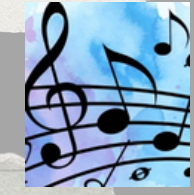


# Computing



Children will use technology to answer a quiz, present a story, make a non-fiction fact file about the UK and make a presentation. The children love Computing and have already shown some very impressive skills!

# Music



To complement our topic, we will be investigating sounds from different parts of the UK - seaside, countryside and city sounds will be explored and we will create our own composition using these sounds.

# Science



Our topic in Science this term is Life cycles. We will find out about human life cycles, match offspring to their parent and explore the life cycle of a chick, butterfly or frog!
