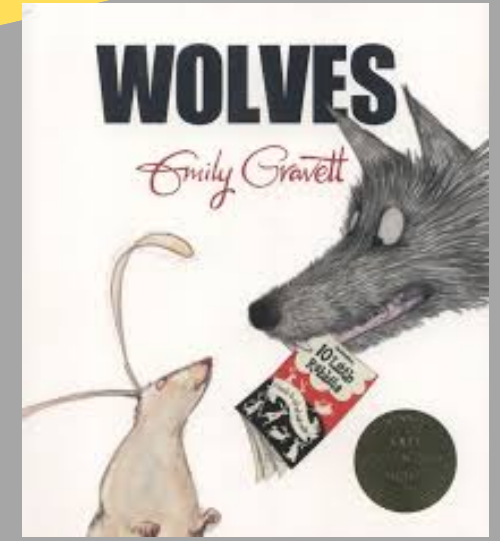


English

Maths

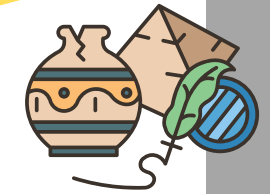

We will be exploring, editing and combining sounds before moving on to adding sounds to a tune to improve it. We will think about how music can express feelings and create tunes which depicts them.

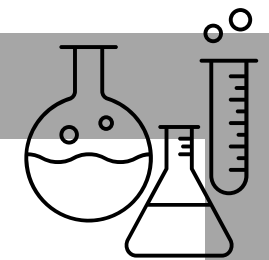
Music



The children learn how events, actions and feelings within stories can be represented by pitch, dynamics and tempo.

Science

We will be looking at where plants and animals can live and what they need to eat to survive in these habitats. We will then move on to learn about food chains and understanding the journey food makes from the farm to the supermarket, such as how milk gets to the fridge!



D.T.



Pupils explore the principles of a healthy and varied diet. Pupils learn where food comes from and how to prepare simple dishes safely and hygienically, using tools such as knives, graters, and scissors under supervision.
