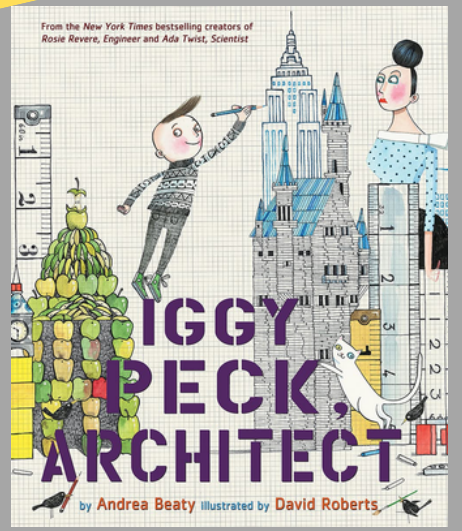


## English

## Maths

Children will understand that numbers up to 20 are made of tens and ones. They will learn to group objects into tens and count the remaining ones, recognize numbers on a number line, and use practical resources like counters or cubes to show how numbers are built.

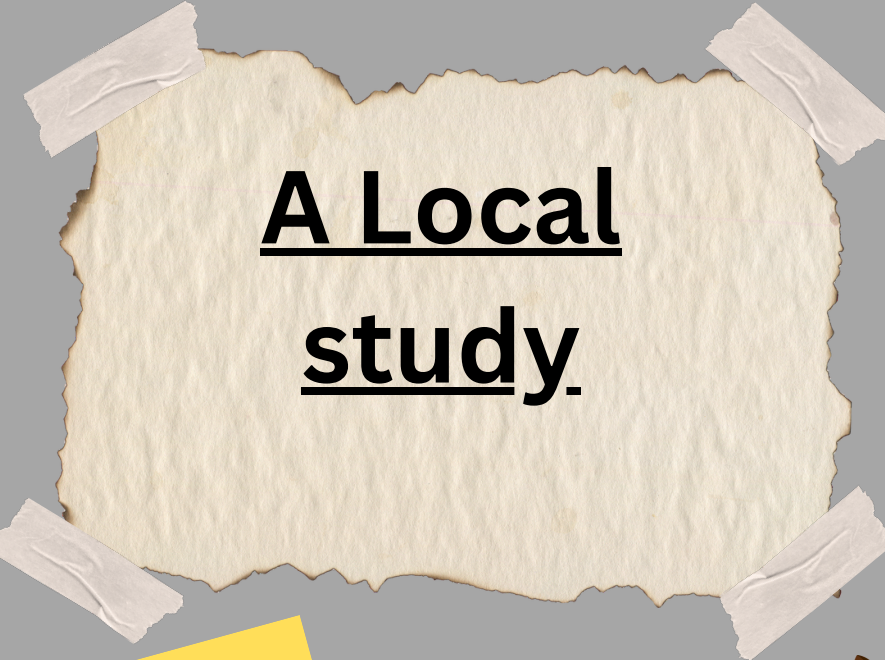


## PSHCE

In PSHCE we will be focusing on what to do in an emergency. Making sure the children are confident in the steps to take and who their trusted adults are.

## History

Our Mary Seacole unit will introduce the children to an important historical figure as they explore who Mary was, why she travelled to the Crimean War, and how she cared for soldiers using her knowledge of healing.



## Computing

We will be learning to understand that an algorithm is a set of instructions. We will follow and create simple instructions on a device and sequence algorithms that require a correct order.

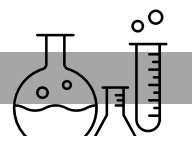


## Music

In music we will be exploring composition. We will be using glockenspiels to emerse ourselves in composing our own musical journeys.

## Science

We will learn that there are 4 seasons- spring, summer, autumn, and winter. Each season has different weather, daylight hours, and changes in nature. We will explore how seasons affect what we wear, what we do.



## Art

We will mix primary colours to make secondary colours. We will practise printing techniques, making sure to apply paint carefully to achieve clear prints and use a range of colours to make them bright and exciting. We will also decorate our hands with lots of patterns and mix colours confidently to paint and design our own plates.



## RE

We will investigate the roles of God through stories and sacred texts. Children will look at the things that God does and what this means to different people.
