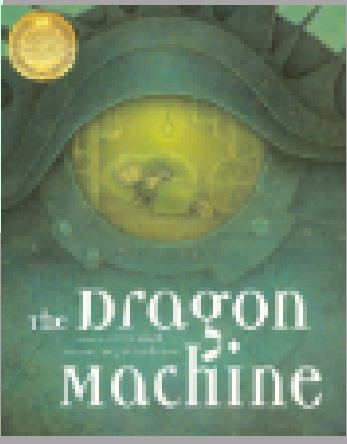
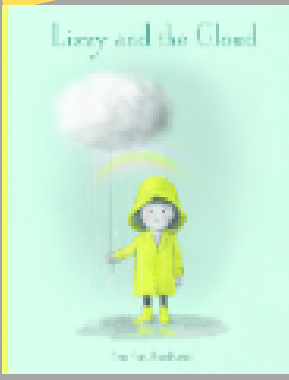


# English

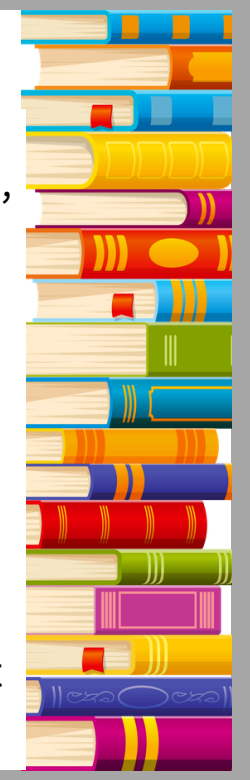

# Reading

Please continue to help your child become a 'Blending Hero' by listening to them read and going through the real and 'alien' words together that we send home. We will also be looking more closely at comprehension and helping the children to retrieve information from texts so that they can answer questions.



# Maths

Remember to log into Numbots and TTRS to challenge yourself at home! Children will be learning about fractions and time this term. They will use their previous knowledge of number skills such as place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division to help them solve problems.



# PSHE



Our topic this term is Safety and the Changing Body. Children will learn about online safety, that some parts of the body are private, respecting boundaries, road safety and safe use of medicine.

# Geography



This term, the children will be learning all about the continents and where the coldest and hottest places on Earth are. Children will identify if they live in a hot or cold climate and will talk about where they would prefer to live!

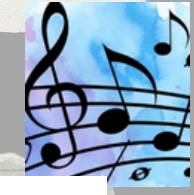


# Computing



Our PSHE topic this term is all about safety and during Computing lessons, children will be exploring how to stay safe online. They will also learn about emails and how to send them and respond.

# Music



In Music, children will be exploring a unit called 'Myths and Legends' and will develop their rhythm, composing and performing skills!

# Science
